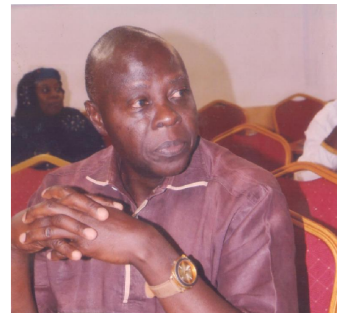


Avis MOMENI ON IGF ACTIVITIES
